Christian Aid Week 10-16th May.

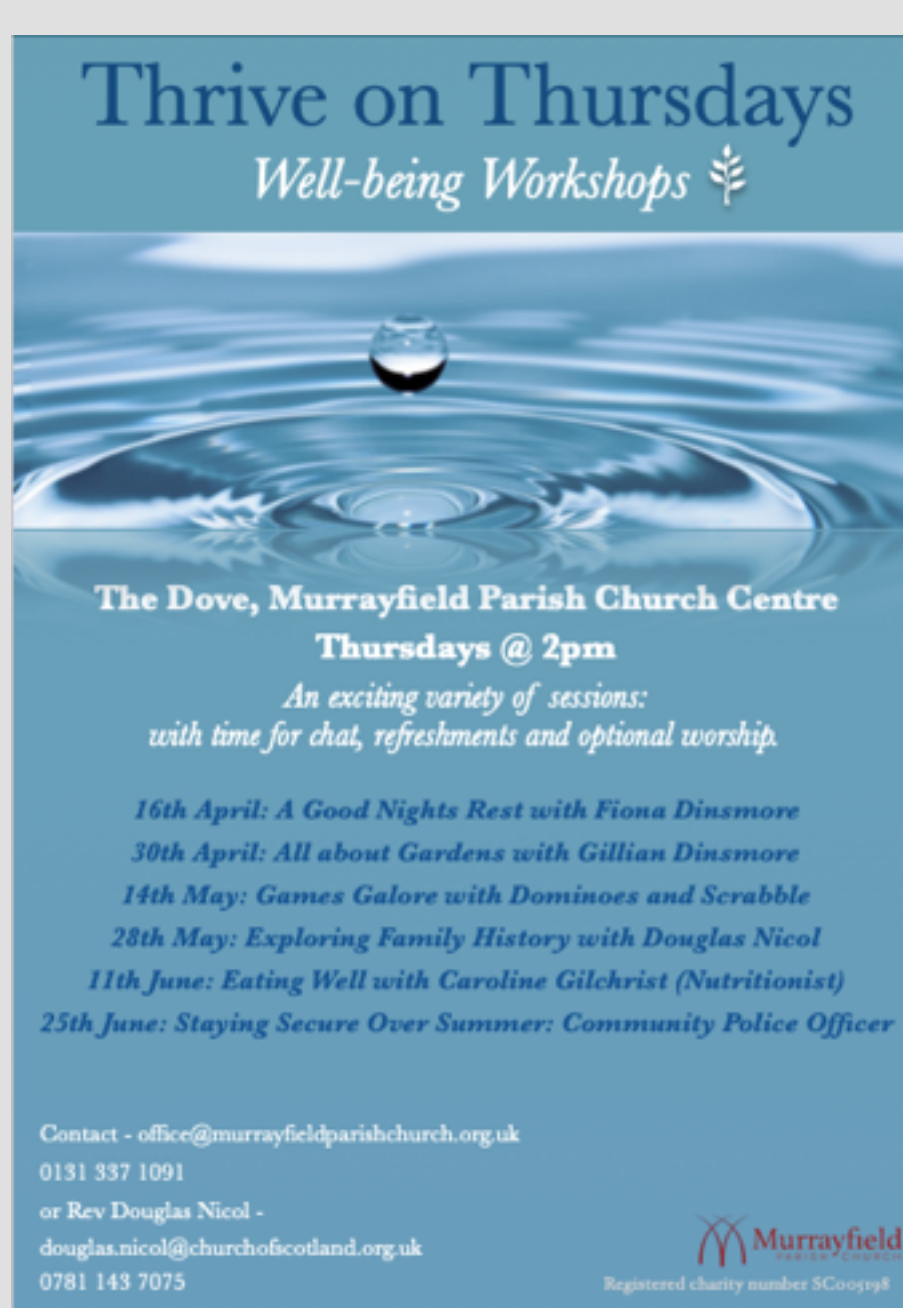

ATTENTION ALL BAKERS!

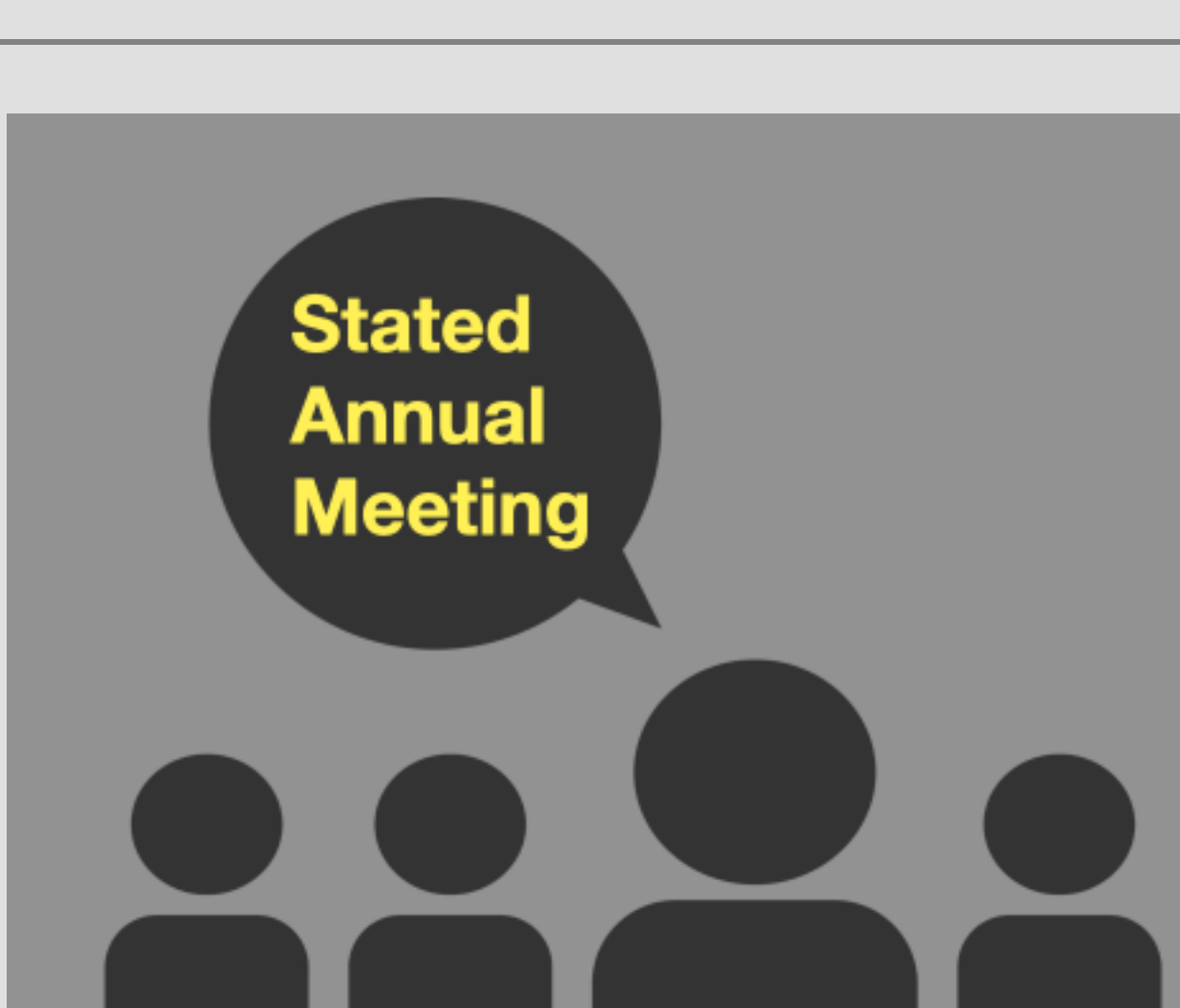
We would love to receive donations of baking for the coffee morning. If you are able to bake please just bring along on the Saturday morning.

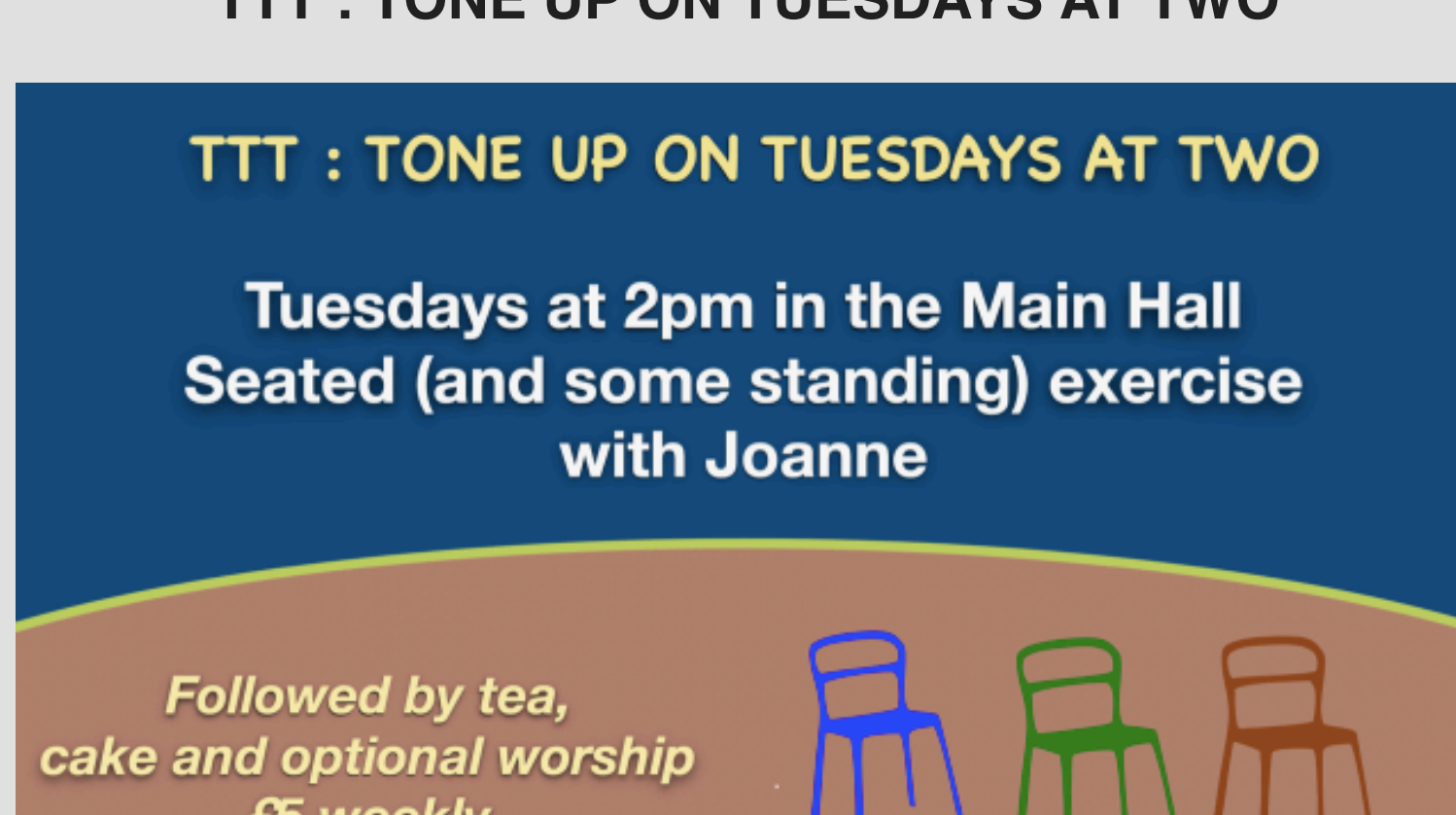
