If you are coming along with children S Club will be available for those of primary school age. There will also be tea and coffee in the Main Hall after the service. Hope to see you there.



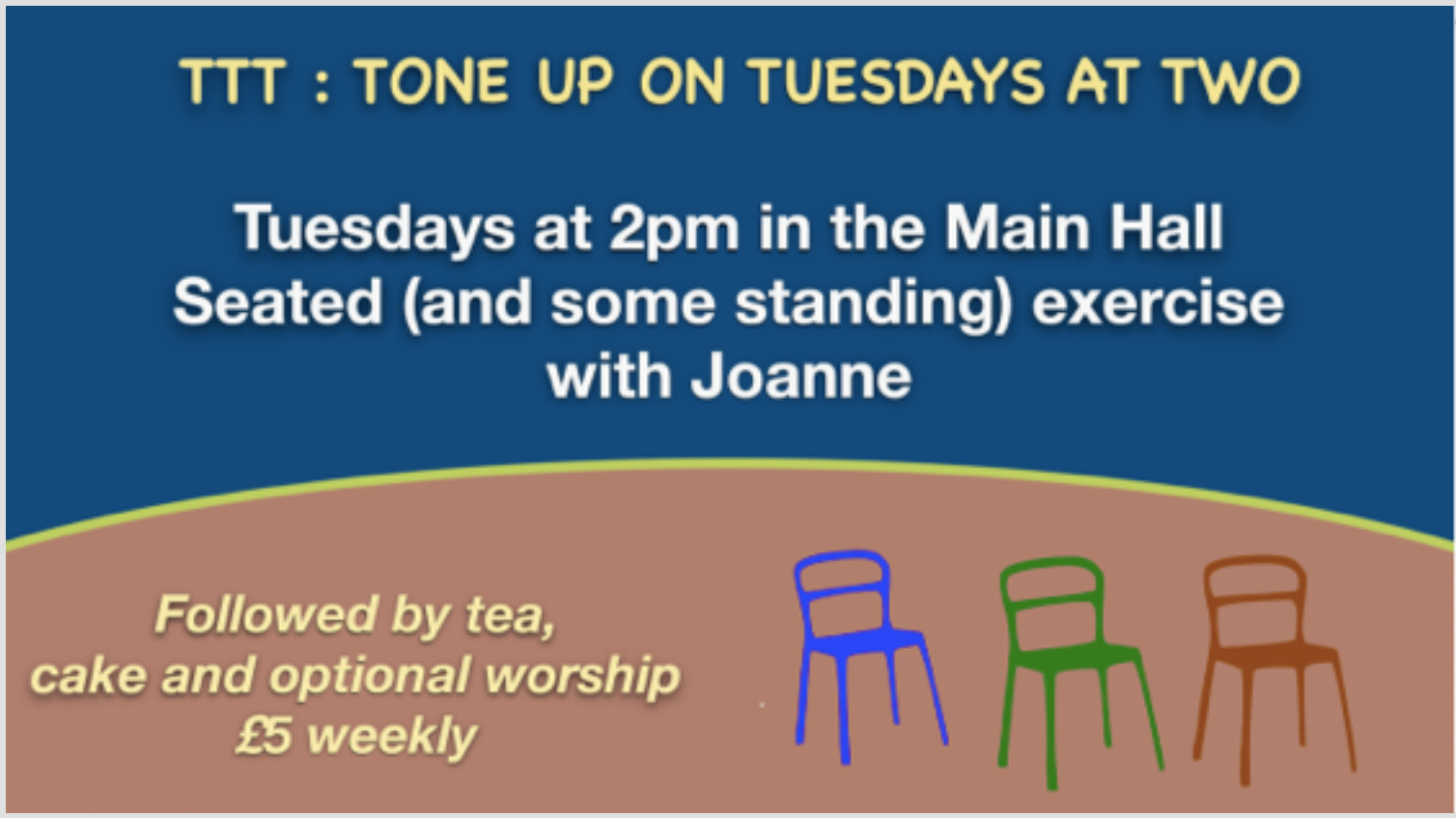
