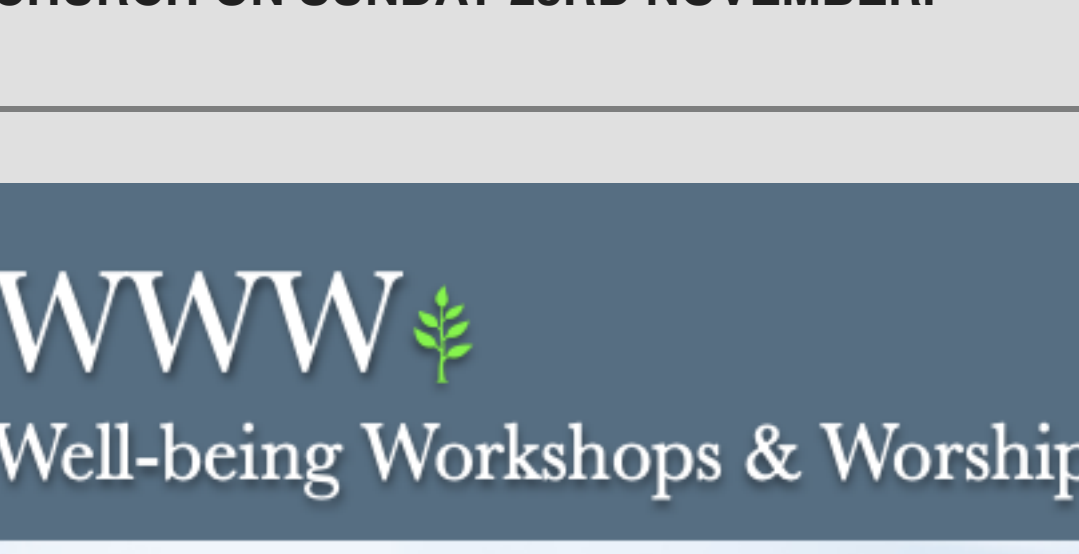




SUNDAY 16TH NOVEMBER 2025

The pots of bulbs for the MCT Ecadare project will be available for sale until the end of November in the church hall after the service.



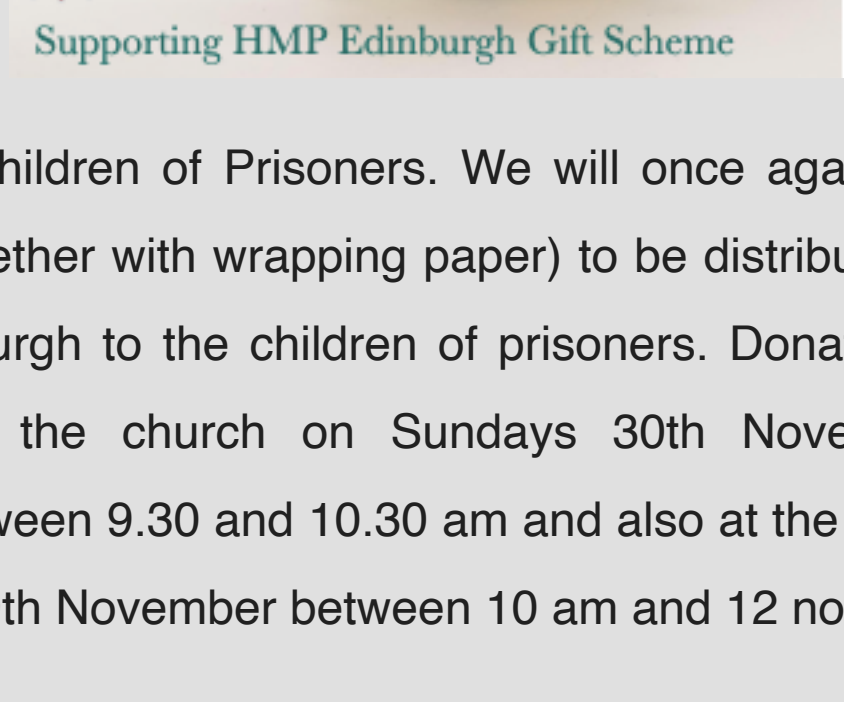

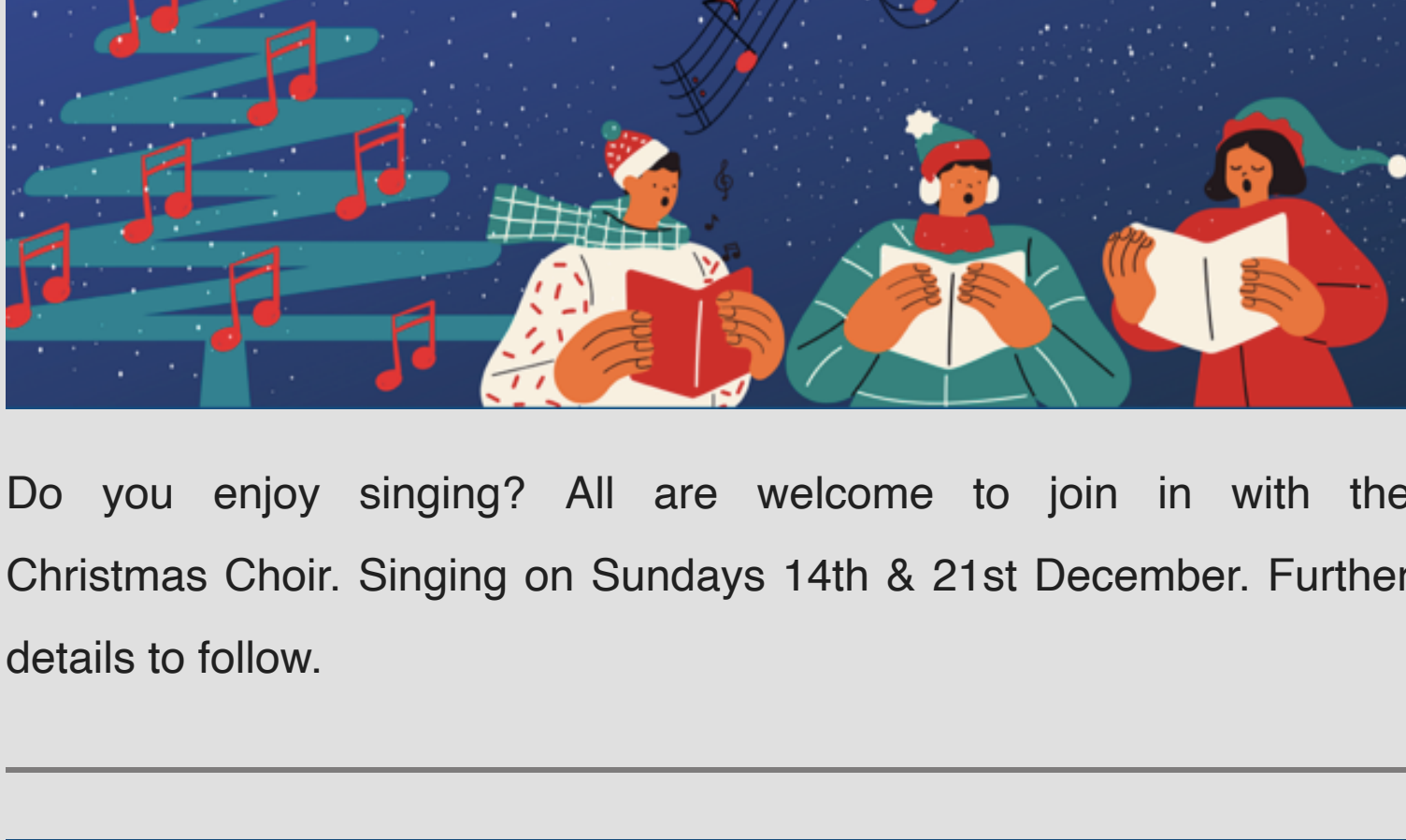
There will be a baking stall at the coffee morning - we would love to receive home baking for the coffee tables and for the baking stall.

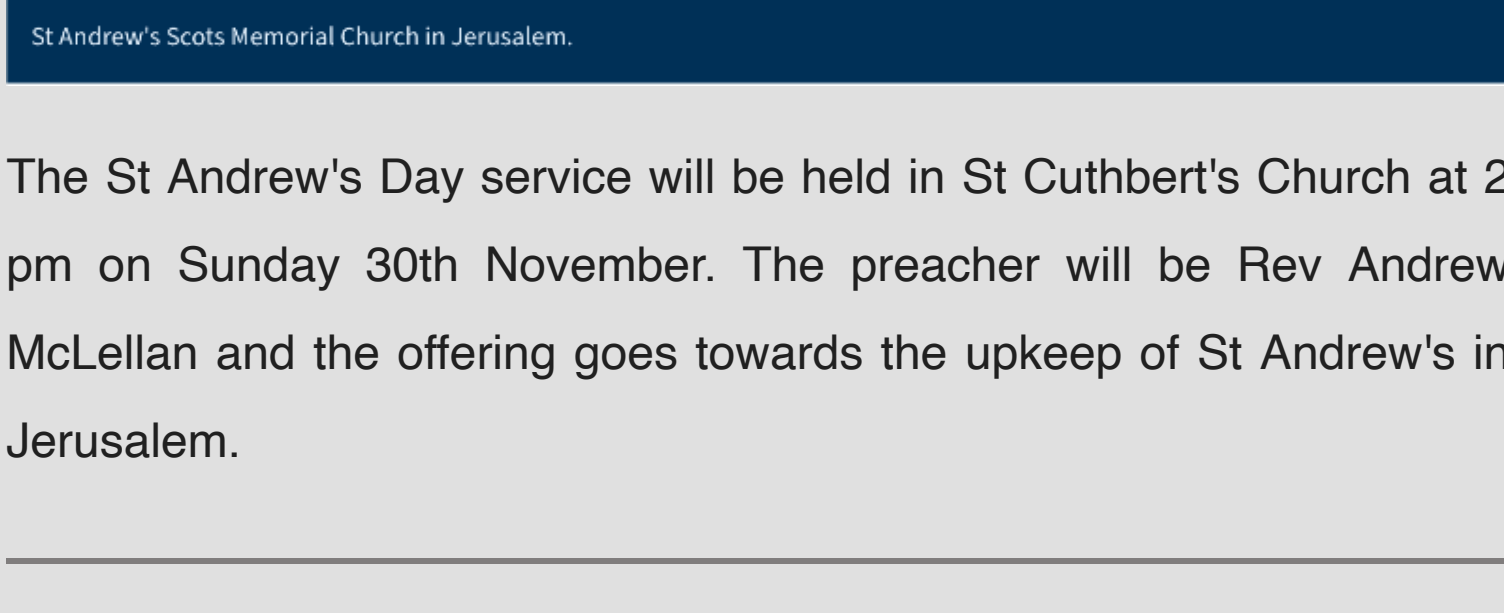
