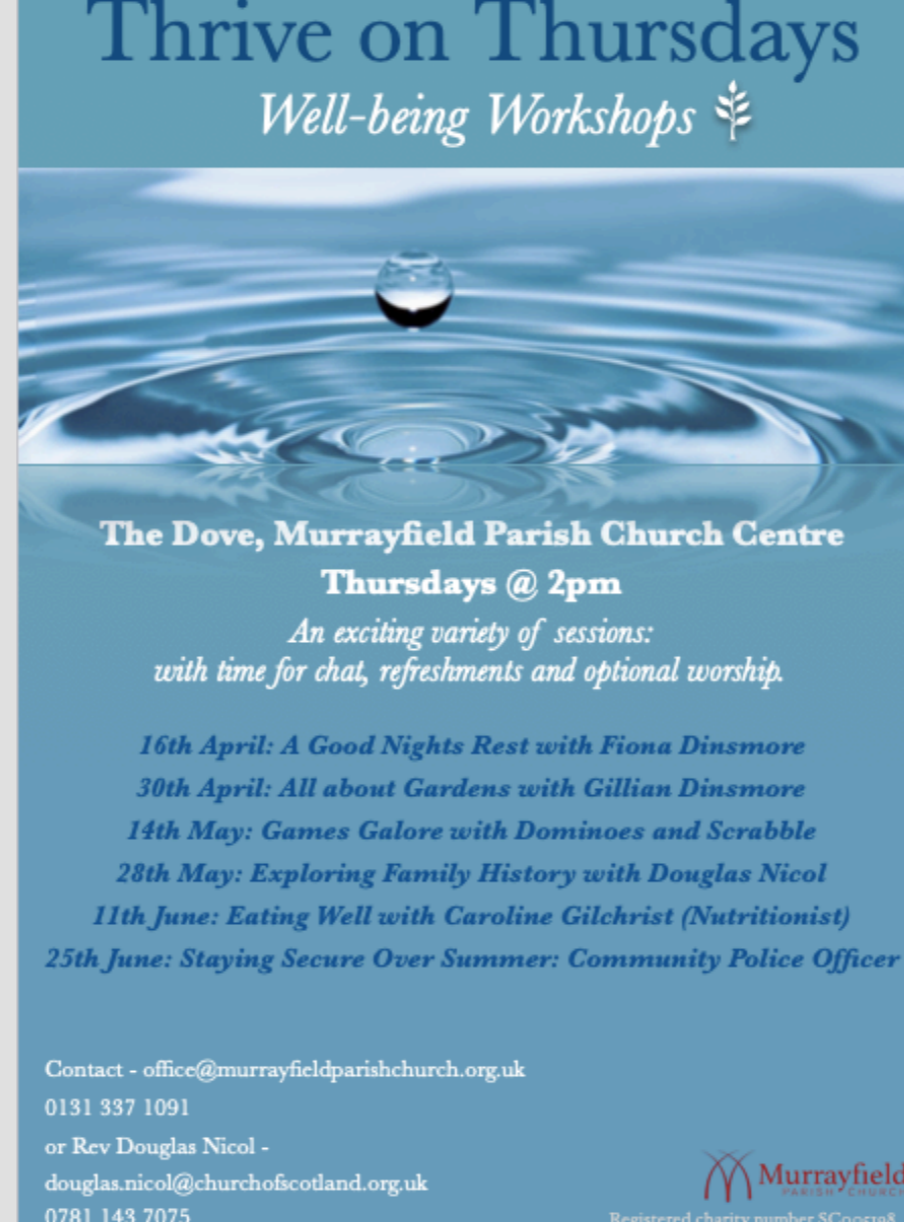


It's almost time for our coffee morning - Let's make this one our best yet!

If you are able to bake please bring your baking along on the Saturday morning.

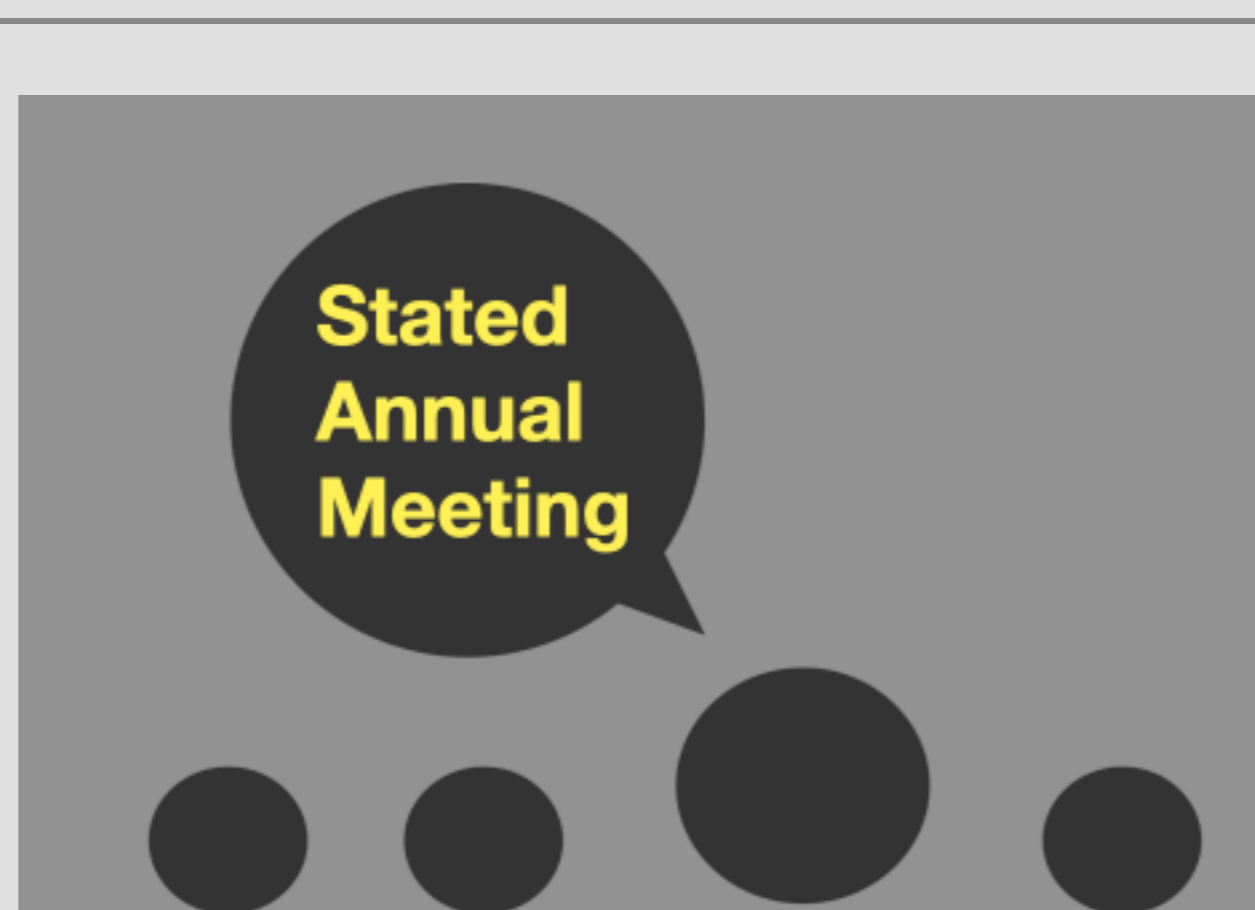

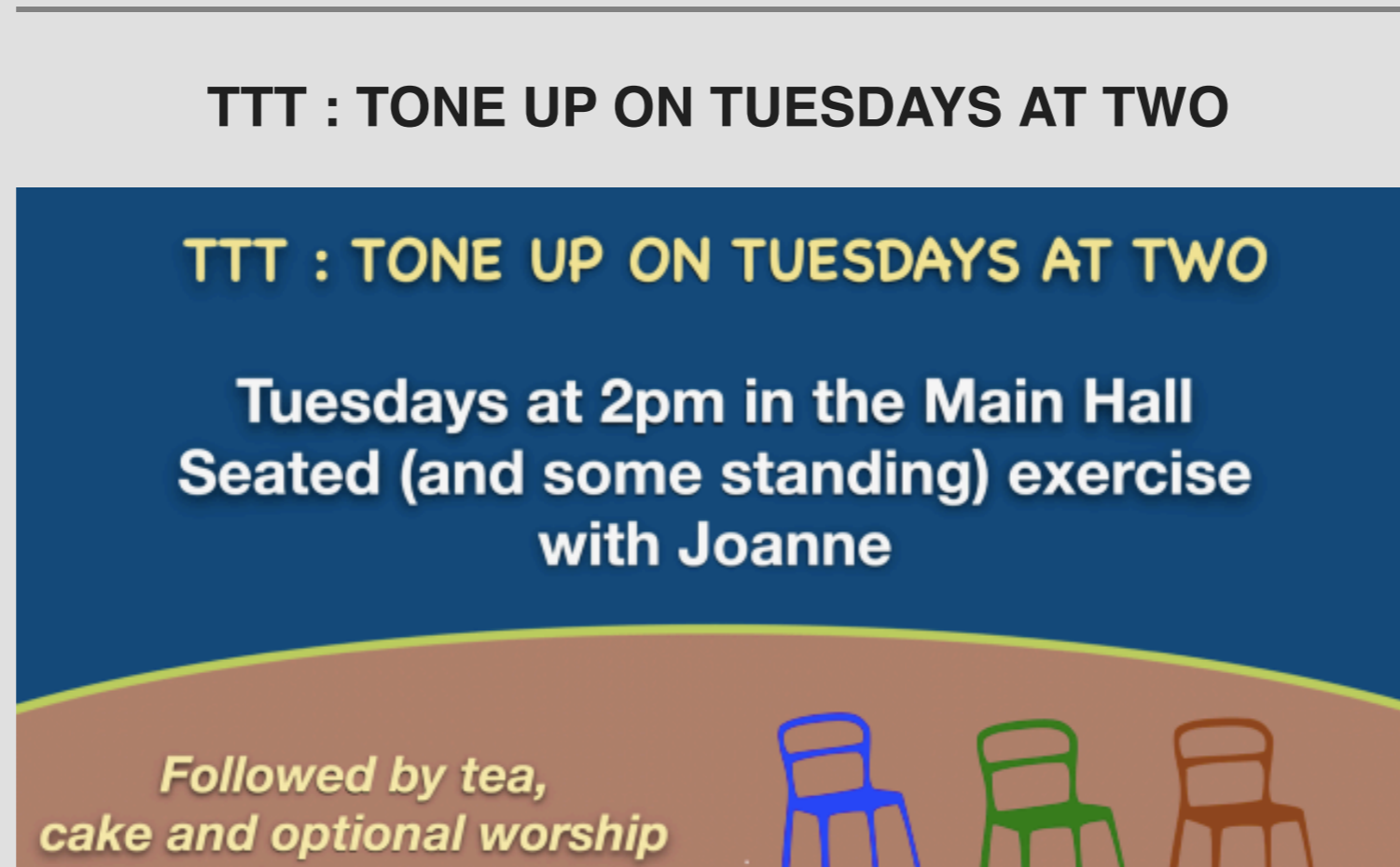

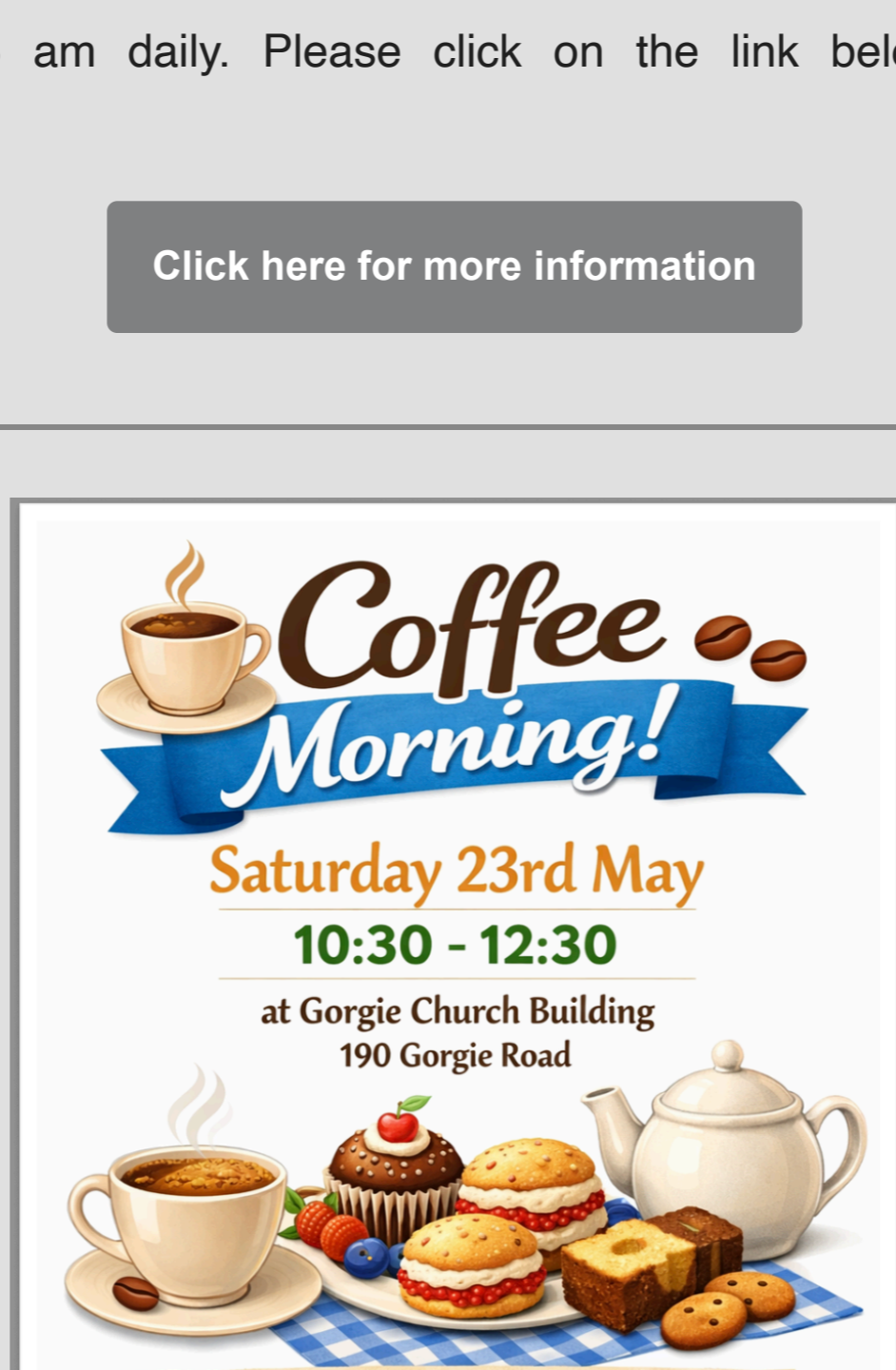
