Important message from Church of Scotland

Communication to Session Clerks and Congregational Treasurers
RE: Fake Websites

We have been made aware today of fake websites which are promoting a Church of Scotland fundraising lottery – both at a national level and also purporting to be individual churches.

These websites look very professional but are nothing to do with the Church of Scotland. Staff at the National Offices have reported this to the appropriate authorities as a matter of urgency.

A key indicator is that the web address being used misspells Scotland with two 'c's.

If any Church members have concerns about these fake websites, they can contact our Law Department via email on LAWDEPT@churchofscotland.org.uk

If you are aware of any individuals having given money to this scam, please ask them to contact Police Scotland.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Church of Scotland does not run a fundraising lottery.
