

There will be tea/coffee in the Main Hall after the service. Hope to see you there.










On Easter Sunday 5th April at 10.30 am we have a joyous celebration of the resurrection. This will include the sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

Church Officer Vacancy

St Ninian's Church of Scotland, Corstorphine, has a vacancy for a Church Officer. This is a part time position of 10 hours per week split over 4 days. The role is during Monday-Friday although occasional Weekends/ Evening working may be required. Duties include:

- Co-ordinating the maintenance and upkeep of the Church buildings on a day-to-day basis. Identifying and reporting issues that arise.
- Negotiate, arrange and coordinate contractors to attend to issues in a timely manner in accordance with the Church's requirements.
- Coordinate and keep records of annual maintenance events such as equipment servicing and heating.
- Ensuring the halls are ready for group hires as well as meeting and getting equipment ready for hire.
- Carrying out annual maintenance tasks where practical.
- Identify and arrange for cleaning services and also be required to ensure that our halls and facilities are kept good for everyone.

Salary is £15,867 pa with any additional hours worked paid pro rata. An interview process will be required to be successful.
