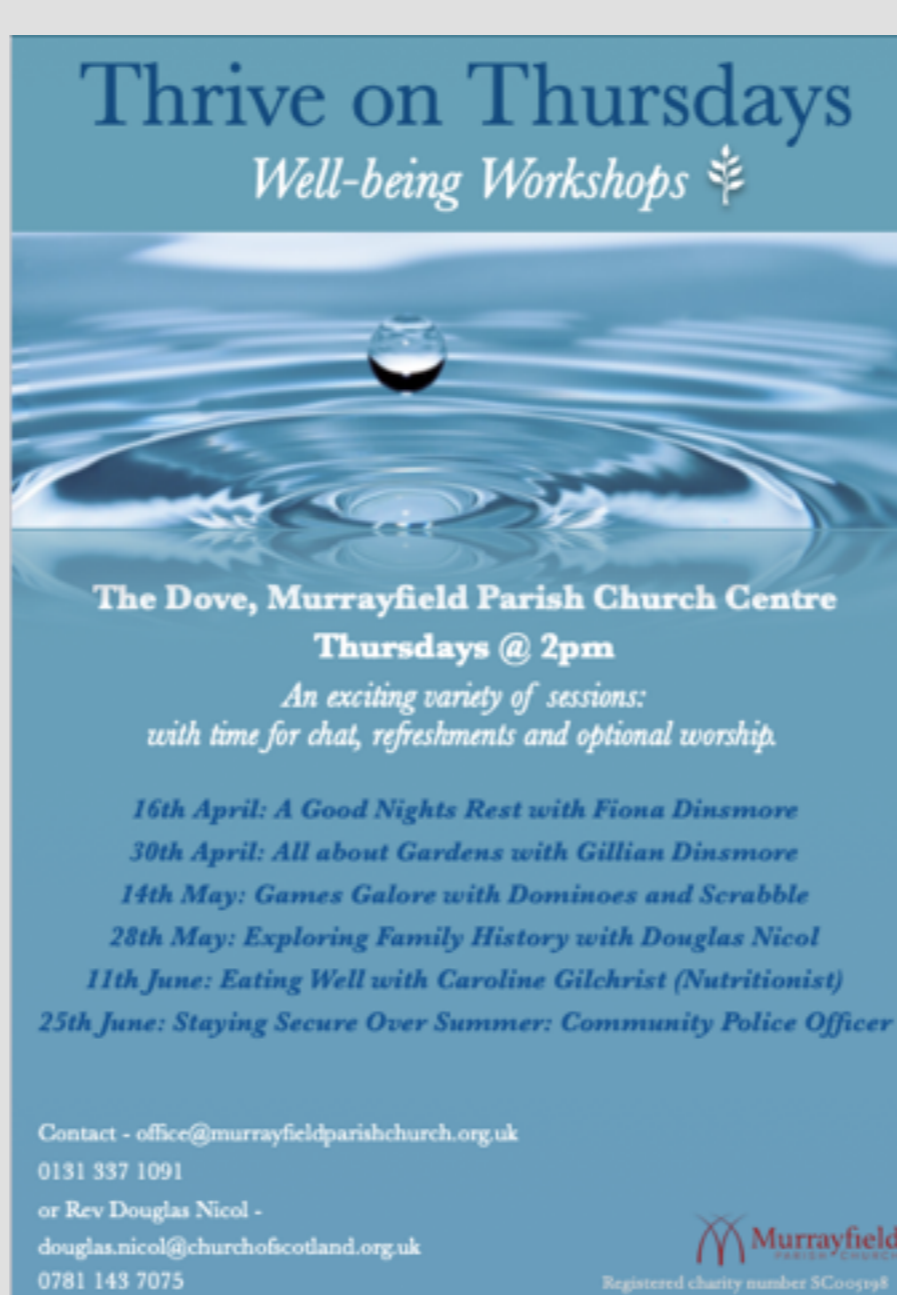
### SUNDAY 26th APRIL 2026

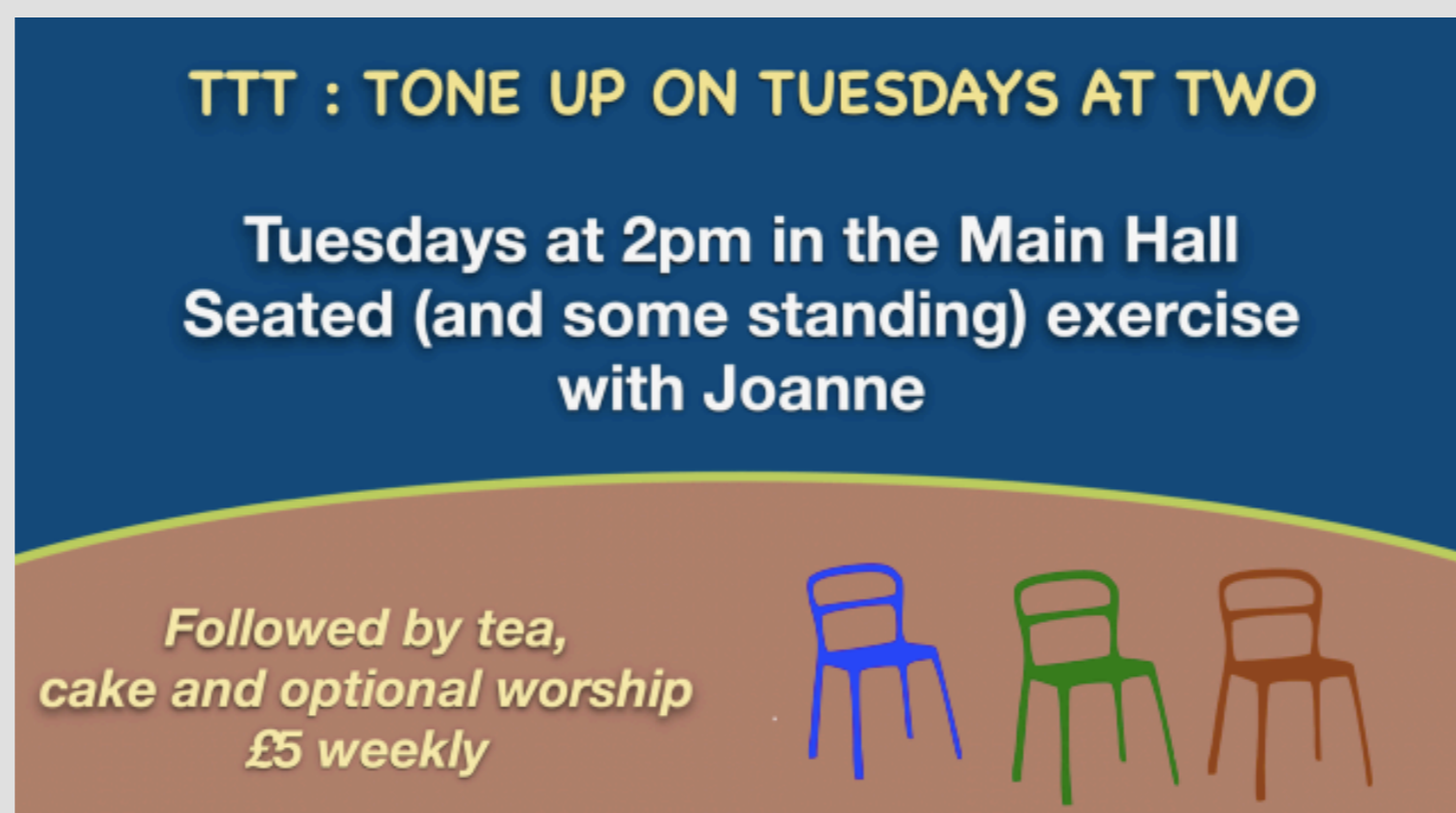
### A DATE FOR YOUR DIARY
