

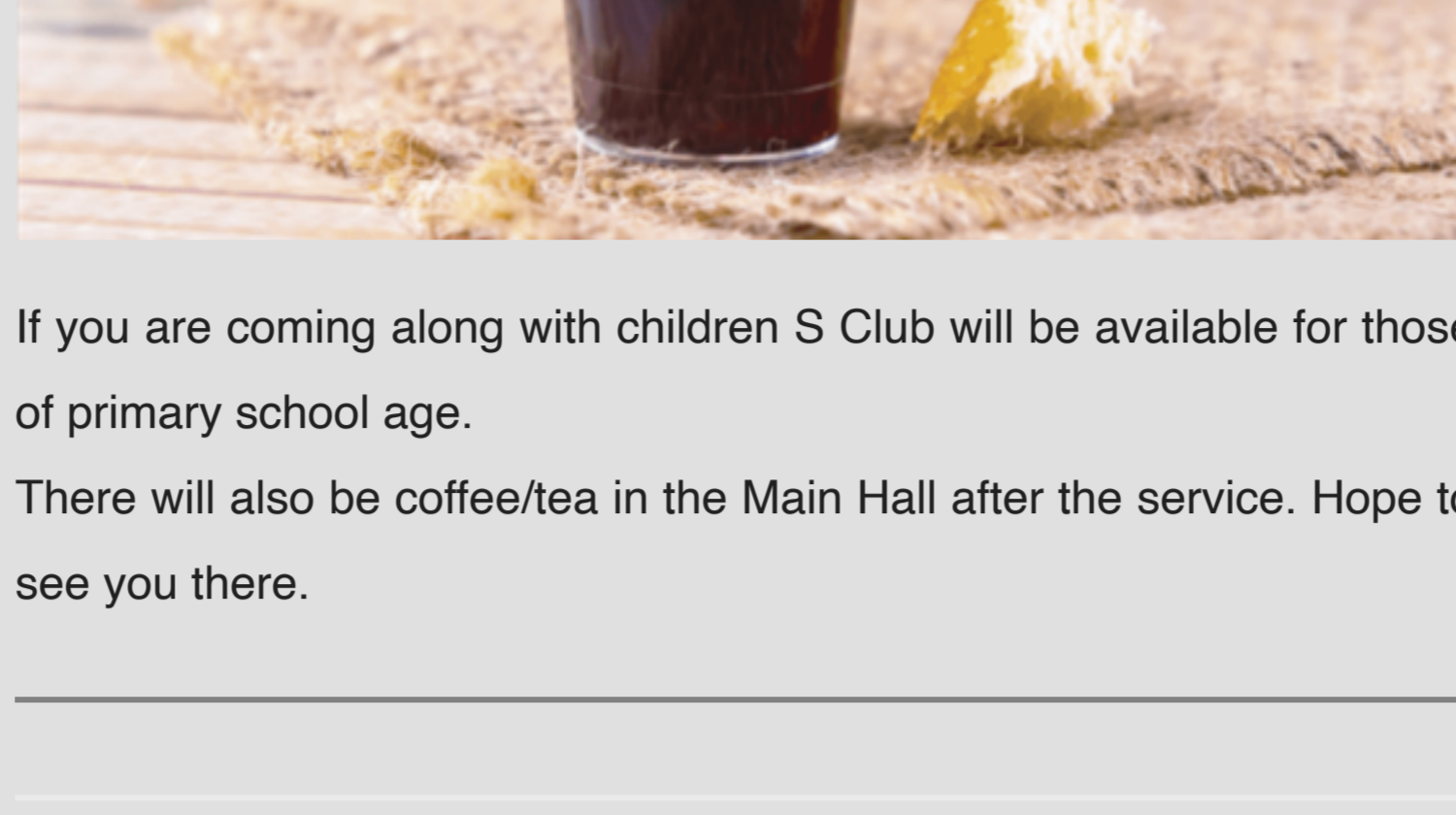

EASTER SUNDAY**



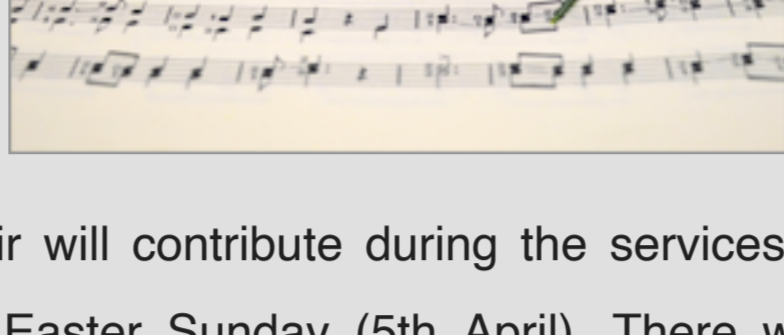

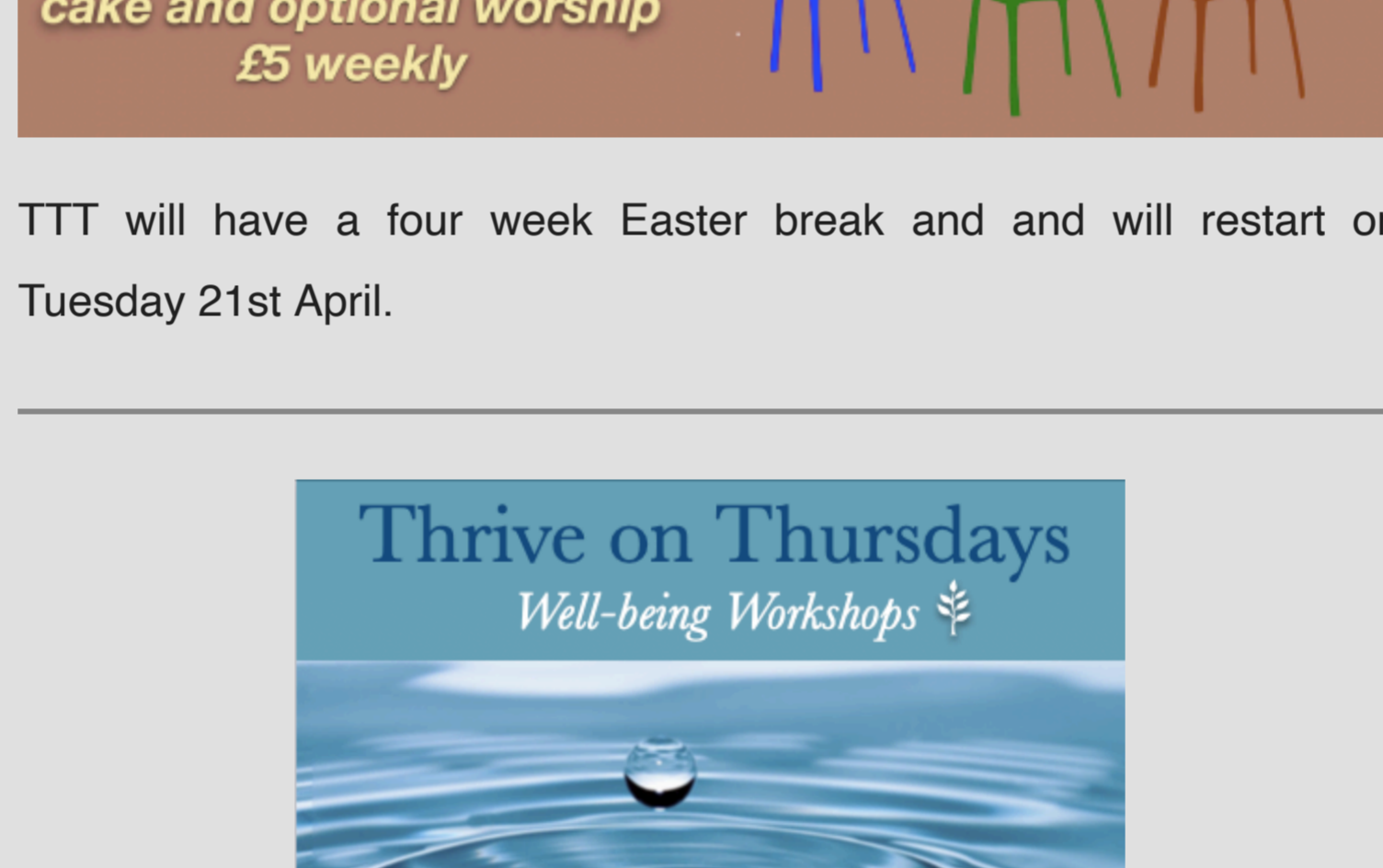
On Easter Sunday 5th April at 10.30 am we have a joyous celebration of the resurrection. This will include the sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

SPRING CLEANING VOLUNTEERS



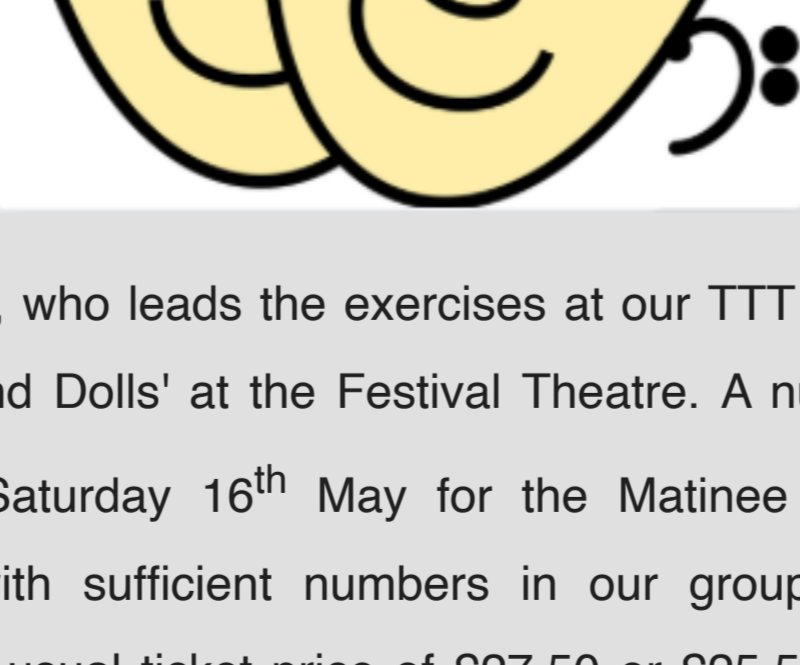

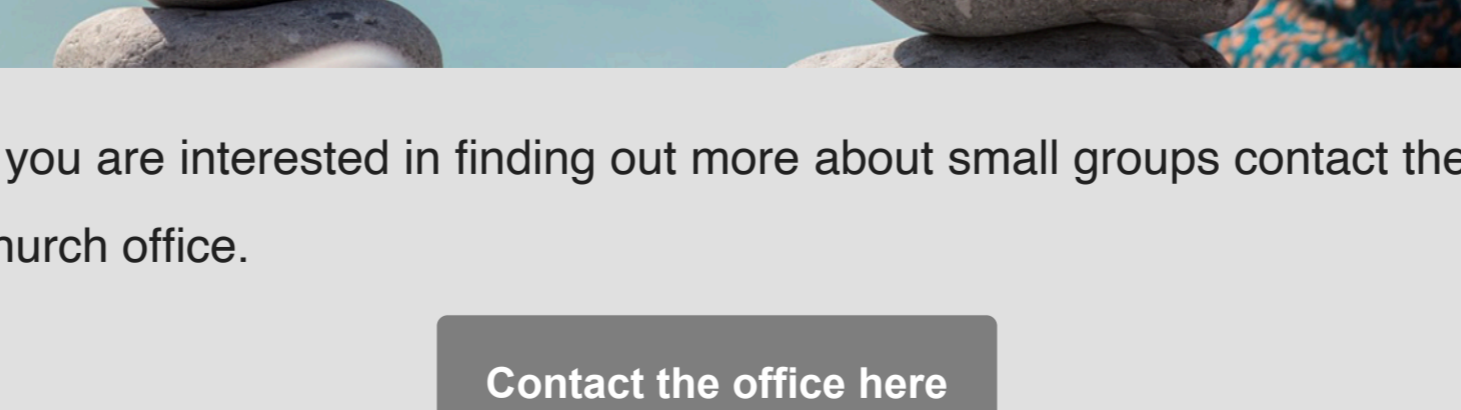


Dove Room 4pm-6pm for primary 7 and up
