STATED ANNUAL MEETING SUNDAY, JUNE 30th




On Sunday, June 30th the Stated Annual Meeting for Murrayfield

The Church of Scotland does not endorse or support individual candidates or parties, but as part of our commitment to the common good many congregations and Christian organisations support participation in democratic activity.

A few reminders for the UK General Election on the 4th July-

- If you need to register you must do so by the 18th June
- The new photo ID requirements mean you will need eligible ID when you vote. This is the first election in Scotland where photo ID is mandatory.
- If you're going to be away from home it is important that you apply for a postal vote by the 19th June or a proxy vote by 26th June
