
Come to one, come to all and bring a friend.

We will restart on Tuesday 7th May and run through till a last class on Tuesday 25th June.


We will then have a summer break.




Don't forget that the clocks are going forward this Sunday.


If placing an order on behalf of your congregation, an invoice will be issued to the Treasurer. Anyone making a personal purchase will pay during the online order process.

A request for volunteers to help with stewarding

The Assembly Business Committee is seeking volunteers to help with stewarding at this year's General Assembly.

Stewarding duties require a moderate level of fitness since a volunteer could be on their feet for up to 2 hours and may need to escort people up or down stairs.

In the case of an emergency, Stewards will be required to assist in the evacuation of the building by directing people to the nearest available exit.

There are three stewarding sessions on each day of three hours in length.

The morning session is 08.30 to 11.30, the lunch time session is 11.30 to 14.30 and the afternoon session is 14.30 to 17.30.

We would very much welcome volunteers for one or more sessions. Indeed it is extremely helpful if a volunteer feels able to help on several days.

**Notes**—Those volunteering for two sessions (08.30 to 14.30 or 11.30 to 17.30 will be provided with a lunch voucher. In every three-hour session there is an opportunity to have a break for tea or coffee.
